**Applications are now being accepted for booth space in the 10th annual Art in the Park Fine Arts Festival in Danville, October 4 & 5, 2008.**

**Categories:** Painting, Photography, Ceramics, Sculpture, Graphics, Fine Jewelry. Work must be original and created by the exhibiting artist. Artist's reproductions of their own paintings and note cards will be accepted as long as the majority of the work for sale is original. ***Absolutely no imports or commercially produced items permitted. No crafts.***

**Booth spaces** are 10'x10' and are open on at least two corners for more display possibilities. Overnight security is provided. Complete set up instructions will be mailed out in September.

**Inside Art Show:** Art in the Park participants will be invited to enter the judged art show in the Community Center, adjacent to Art in the Park. Monetary awards and ribbons will be given. There is no extra fee for two entries per booth. Details will be sent sometime around the end of August.

**Fees: ADAS Members: \$70 Non-Members: \$ 85**

**Optional Early Set Up (Friday 3:00 to 7:00 pm) \$25**

At the end of the show, a commission of 10% on all sales will be collected which goes directly into the ADAS Art in the Schools fund.

**ADAS Membership Available** at \$30 per year. Membership form will be sent on request.

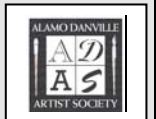
**Deadline:** To be considered for the April jury selection, applications must be postmarked no later than April 1. Applications received after that date will be considered on a space available basis. (Jewelry & photography categories usually close by April deadline.) Notifications of acceptance will be mailed by April 15th.

**Include Photos:** New Applications, send 4 clear photos of your work plus one of your display (or detailed description). Previous Participants: 1 photo representative of your work.
