## Creating Community Through The Arts

### City of San Ramon Art Banner Project

#### Description:

The City of San Ramon Arts Advisory Committee and Parks and Community Services Department are inviting artists to participate in the City's "Creating Community Through The Arts" Banner Project. Artists will be provided with banner material on which to paint original artwork. One side of each banner contains a common graphic but the other side will be an original work of art. The art banners will be displayed on streetlight poles throughout the City during the fall, in time for the San Ramon Arts Walk and Festival at Windemere and the Black and White Benefit. When the banners are taken down in November, they will be auctioned and sold at an event in December to raise funds for a second banner project and a public art fund program.

The goal of the Art Banner Project is to expand the nature of art in public places by creating an outdoor art gallery that helps build community and public appreciation for the arts.

This project is funded by the San Ramon Arts Foundation and coordinated by Artful Solutions.

#### Eligibility:

This project is open to all San Ramon Valley artists 16 yrs. and older. All images/designs must be original works of art and appropriate for all viewing ages.

#### Entry requirements:

The theme is "Creating Community Through Theater, Music, Dance & Visual Arts".

Submitting artists **MUST** complete an application and submit a colored sketch drawn to the scale (6"x16") of the banner to be considered by the jury. Bright colors with contrasting colors and simple designs are suggested. Banners will be viewed from distances of 8 to 50 feet or more so imagery with exaggerated contrast will work the best. **Designs MUST be appropriate for all ages to view with no logos, advertising or messages of any kind. The jury will not consider designs with inappropriate subject matter, text or imagery.** If you have any questions or concerns about your design, please contact the art banner coordinator before beginning your sketch. If you wish to have your design returned, please

enclose a self-address stamped envelope with the application and sketch.

#### Dates and Deadlines:

**June 16, 2006** - Prospective designs must be delivered to the Art Banner Coordinator at the Dougherty Station Community Center located at 17011 Bollinger Canyon Road by 5pm.

**June 21, 2006 - July 25, 2006** - San Ramon Arts Advisory Committee, Parks and Community Services Commission and City Council will review and jury the designs. The designs will be judged for creativity and visual impact from a distance.

**July 26, 2006** - Selected artists will be notified and asked to pick up the provided vertical 94" by 30" banners made of polyester/vinyl material banners at Dougherty Station Community Center's front desk no later than July 31, 2006.

**August 25, 2006** - Completed banners are to be delivered to the Dougherty Station Community Center no later than 5pm.

**September 1, 2006** - Banners will be installed and be displayed on streetlight posts throughout San Ramon.

**September 22, 2006** - Art reception for all participating artists at the San Ramon Arts Walk and Festival at Windemere. You are encouraged to invite your family and friends. This will be a free event open to the public.

**November 24, 2006** - Banners will be removed from streetlight posts and given to the Art Banner Coordinator to clean and prepped for auction.

**December 2006** - Banners will be auctioned off at a San Ramon Arts Foundation event and artists' reception for all participating artists. The goal is to raise funds for a second banner project and also build a Public Art Fund for the City of San Ramon. The exact date and event details TBD.

**The completed banner and design becomes the property of the City of San Ramon.**

**Saturday, 03 June: Close of entries.** The following must be received at The Gallery by 5:30 p.m.:

Up to 4 slides or photos for artwork; sample text for poetry

**Entry Fee: \$30.00 [DACA Members: \$20.00], payable to DACA.**

**Saturday, 10 June: Drop off accepted works:** at Gallery, **3:30 – 5:30 p.m.**

**Saturday, 17 June: Show Opens:** Public Reception for Artists and Guests, **4:00 – 6:00 p.m.**

**Friday, 28 July: Show Closes** at 6:00 p.m., the end of The Gallery day

**Saturday, 29 July: Show Closed:** Pick up works at The Gallery, **1:30 – 3:30 p.m.**

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**Exhibit Information:**

**Please be aware that the Gallery is on the Second Floor (no elevator) and the entry access is limited to a 30" width, a 65" height, and a hard right turn at the top of the landing.**

Entry fee covers up to 4 works per artist (and any additional works at the discretion of The Director).

Artwork may be "For Sale," or "Not For Sale."

No resale license is necessary. All works are consigned to The Gallery, which collects and pays current required sales tax.

**The Gallery commission is 35% of artist's sale price.** The artist receives 65% of artist's sale price.

Work is covered by The Gallery insurance after work is delivered, during the show, and up to the pickup date. **Please note that there is a \$250.00 deductible per artwork.** Artist assumes the risk for the \$250 deductible for each piece of artwork listed in the entry form, and is responsible for insurance at all other times.

Two dimensional works must be suitably framed (nothing heavy or ornate), except for works on canvas with painted-around edges. Hanging hardware on any works must be flush-mounted. Ends of wires must be taped. Glass or plexi must be clean.

**The Director reserves the right to refuse any work.**

**A \$10 per day storage fee will be charged for works remaining after the pick-up date!** Unless otherwise arranged with The Director, work not claimed within 30 days becomes the property of The Gallery.
